Junior Membership Details

Membership Details

- » Juniors must be between the age of 8 and 19 years.
- » Juniors are only eligible to participate in BCGA and CJGA sanctioned events if they are 18 years of age or younger.
- » Juniors are required to have their own set of clubs while golfing.
- » Parents must provide the junior's birth certificate when applying for junior membership.
- » As a junior member, you will receive a Mayfair Lakes Golf & CC bag tag, and Golf Canada handicap membership.
- » Junior Membership is valid until February 28, 2020.
- » All program fees are non-refundable.

Booking Privileges

- » Juniors will be allowed to call the Golf Shop or book online after 2pm to book for the following day. This privilege is under the discretion of the Golf Shop. Otherwise golf is available on a drop in basis.
- » If playing with an adult, regular privileges would apply - 13 days in advance for non-members, 21 days in advance for members.
- » Guests accompanying a junior member and playing a round of golf will receive the member/guest rate for the green fee.

Practice Facility Privileges

- » One bucket per day (80 practice balls).
- » Access, upon availability, to all practice facilities: Driving Range, Practice Greens, and Practice Bunkers.

Facility Privileges

- » Juniors will receive the member's discount on all regularly priced clothing and accessories in the Golf Shop.
- » Lakeside Grill is open for junior members to enjoy meals at all hours unless there is a function in progress.

Junior Member/Guest

- ▶ Each junior member has the opportunity to bring a friend and play in a team format.

PGA of BC Pro-Junior Qualifier and Event

- ▶ One junior from each handicap group will join one of our Mayfair Lakes Golf Professionals at the PGA of BC Pro-Junior Tournament. There will be an 18-hole qualifier to determine a winner for each handicap group. This qualifying event is open to all juniors with an established Golf Canada handicap.

Junior Club Championship

- ▶ The club championship is a two-day stroke play competition with 3 different age groups for the boys and a girls division. Dinner and prizes are provided at the end of the second round. All juniors with an established Golf Canada handicap are welcome to participate.

Junior League Mayfair Cup

- ▶ Junior Golf League will provide junior with a positive and fun-filled junior golf experience. Accumulate points through the season, winners will be declared at the end of the year.

CN Future Links Skills Competition

- ▶ The CN Future Links Skills Competition is focused on developing key golf skills of putting, chipping, iron play and driving. Skills are broken up into 3 separate age categories: participants aged 8 and under, 9 to 11, participants aged 12 to 14 and participants aged 15 to 18. Results from Mayfair will be used as qualifiers for the National Event Final at the end of the golf season.

New Competitor

Target Age Group: 8 to 14 +/- years old

Program Objectives

- » Introduction of a reasonable balance between training (60%) and competition (40%) to foster ongoing development.
- » Provide age/stage appropriate competitive experiences where success and results are important but not the top priority.
- » This age group will experience the most significant period of skill development as this is the window of accelerated adaptation to motor coordination – this is commonly referred to as the “Optimal Window of Trainability”. This is why a primary focus on skill development & training is so critical at this stage vs. competition.

Seven Core Modules

- » The seven core modules that apply to each stage of the Learn to Compete program. PGA of Canada coaches will utilize these core modules within practice plans to enhance the athletes’ learning experience.



Details

- » The New Competitor program will include **twelve group coaching sessions scheduled once a week.**

Practice Facility

- » Unlimited tokens to be used only by the junior member.

The “Fine Print”

1. Absolutely no possession and/or consumption of alcohol or smoking on Mayfair Lakes property.
2. Prior to playing golf, junior golfers will be required to check in with Golf Shop staff.
3. The dress code is in effect at all times and applies to all areas of the golf club. Dress code includes a collared shirt and tailored pants or shorts. Jeans and track pants are not considered appropriate for golf.
4. Proper golf etiquette will be enforced on the golf course. (Rake bunkers, repair ball marks, replace divots, pace of play, attitude)
5. Junior golfers under the age of 18 may not operate a power cart under any circumstances. Junior golfers 18 and older wishing to rent a power cart must present a valid driver’s license and cannot ride with juniors under the age of 18.
6. Retrieving golf balls out of the lake is prohibited.
7. Access to members’ locker rooms and fitness center available only when invited and supervised by an adult member of the facility.
8. Member’s Lounge is off limits to all junior members.
9. Putting greens around the facility are reserved for putting and chipping only. Please refrain from pitch shots and high lofted shots.

Disciplinary Process

1st Offense	Verbal warning
2nd Offense	Written warning
3rd Offense	One-month suspension of all membership privileges
4th Offense	Permanent suspension of membership for the year with no refund
